## CDCC member World Champion x 2

CDCC member Alex Edmondson can now add dual Junior World Champion to his already impressive cycling CV.

Alex was part of the world record breaking, gold medal winning pursuit team on the opening day of competition at the 2011 UCI Junior Track World Championships in Moscow. The team comprising Alex, Jackson Law, Alexander Morgan and Jack Cummings posted a time of 4:02.400 to defeat the Russians over the 4000m ride and take the world record.

On the final night of competition, Alex teamed with Jackson Law in the 30km Madison to take their second gold medal and the sixth for Australia. Alex and Jackson can now add their names to a growing list of Australian cyclists who have succeeded in this historic event.

# Letter from Alex Edmondson

Hi All,

(letter to CSA following his team pursuit victory)

Had an amazing day yesterday.

We had the team pursuit qualifying in the morning session and then if we made the final it would be in the afternoon session. The team was defending world Team Pursuit Champion Jackson Law, plus Alex Morgan, Jack Cummings and myself. We knew that we were going to be competitive but weren't sure what the other teams were going to be like.

In the heat we were the last team to go off as Australia had won last year. The fastest time was set by the Russian's in a 4.08, and we were to go out on a 4.05; I was leading the team out of the starting gate. We were up on our schedule during our qualifying and ended up riding a 4.04.8 only 400th off the world record. We were now in the final against the Russians.

We knew that the Russians were going to come at us hard from the gun, but we just had to all have faith and full belief in Tim Decker our coach. We were going to have ride faster than the heat if we wanted the record and probably to Win!

Before we started we received a very inspirational speech to get us G'ed up for the final. If we were to win we would be the first Australian Team to win on Russian soil.

The gun started, the first 2 laps the Russians were up but all of a sudden we lifted and started to get them in our sights. We were absolutely bombing but at the same time everyone was hanging on! Once we hit that finish line it all hit us, we were the 2011 Junior World Team Pursuit Champions and also World Record Holders!

It was an amazing day for us 4 and also the whole Australian Junior Team and everyone who has supported us.

I would just like to take the time to thank Caleb Ewan even though he didn't get to ride the Team Pursuit, we wouldn't have been able to do what we did without him.

I'd like to thank Tim Decker for all those countless hours and his commitment to all of us, and Michelle Decker as well for all her hard work and time. Also thanks to the rest of the Junior Worlds team and all the people back at home who have helped me.
