CDCC members shine in Italy



CDCC Member **Damien Howson** won the 14th Trofeo San Rocco Junior International Race (104km) at Fabbrica di Peccioli, Italy, on July 18. Damien was in training for the Junior Road World Championships held in Offida, Italy, earlier this month.

Fellow CDCC member, **Dale Parker**, was also in the Australian Team for the Junior Road World Championships, contesting the Time Trial. Dale finished fourth in this event over 28.5km after suffering a rear wheel puncture.

Dale had a busy schedule in Italy as he was also in the Australian Team for the Junior Track World Championships held in Montichiari. Dale won a silver medal in the 3km men's individual pursuit. Unfortunately Dale was taken to hospital after complaining of feeling faint and kept overnight for treatment which meant that he could not take his place in the teams pursuit.



Matthew Glaetzer won two gold medals and a silver medal at the Junior Track World Championships. Matt won gold in his premier event, the Men's sprint, and teamed with Maddison Hammond and Jamie Green to win silver in the Men's team sprint. Matt also won gold in the Men's Keirin.

The Australian Team had amazing success at the Junior Track World Championships as summed up here by Matt Glaetzer:

"There are riders who have had tough runs but bounced back and people who have just done everything right and are getting the results they deserve," said Glaetzer of the team. "Everyone is just so proud of each other and it's been a fantastic world championships and a huge achievement that we're all really proud of and thankful we were able to experience."
