Tour to be conducted over 2 days / 4 stages consisting of 3 road stages and an individual time trial.

Stage Order will be

Saturday - Stage 1 road race, Stage 2 road race

Sunday - Stage 3 individual time trial, Stage 4 road race

Event to be held at - South Australian Company Store - 27 Valley Road ANGASTON SA 5353

Categories for the event are:

Under 17 Men

Under 17 Women

Under 15 Men

Under 15 Women

Under13 Boys/Girls Combined - 2 Stages held on Sunday only

Race Rules: Junior Tour Rules and Regulations

It is the responsibility of all riders to know the course of each stage for their category.

This event is managed to conform to the requirements of the S.A. Road Traffic Act (RTA) and Cycling SA (CSA). All RTA and CSA rules must be observed and obeyed at all times. Speed restrictions will be in place around the course and must be adhered to at all times.

Riders must keep to the left-hand side of the road at all times. No rider shall cross the centre line on a public road during the race. Infringement of the regulations or riding in a dangerous manner may see the rider penalized by warning, fine, relegation, disqualification, or suspension.

Racing numbers will be issued upon presentation of a current GOLD racing licence. Riders must **SIGN ON THEMSELVES** (both days) and collect their **Race Pack** (first day only) before the nominated sign on close off time. Riders will be issued with 2 race numbers, a transponder and a coloured helmet cover (which will distinguish their race category). These are all to be returned at the end of the event when recovering their race licence. Non-return of the above will incur a fine of \$50. Race numbers, transponder and helmet cover are to be retained by the rider overnight on Saturday unless they are retiring from the event.

Race number placement – one number should be placed on the rear centre of the back and the second number should be placed on the left side of the jersey (near the hip). A diagram on where to place this will be in the rider pack handed out at sign on.

For the Time Trial stage - only the back number is required to be worn.

Transponder Placement – please ensure you place the mounting device on your front fork securely for the bike you are using for each stage. A diagram on where to place this will be in the rider pack handed out at sign on.

All riders will race in age and gender categories except the U13 category where girls and boys will race as one category.

Riders are not to warm up on the race circuit whilst a race is in progress.

Riders must be lined up at the start of each Stage at least 10 minutes prior to the posted start time.

Riders must be courteous to local traffic and pedestrians.

Official vehicles will provide support throughout the event in the form of lead, spares and follow vehicles. Signage will be provided to distinguish that a car is an official vehicle.

In an attempt to reduce congestion and minimize impact on the community, **rider parents and supporters are not permitted to follow the race (unless they are part of the official race convoy). Unauthorised following vehicles may attract a penalty to riders associated with the vehicle.**

If you want to be a spectator on the course, please travel the course in the opposite direction to the race. We ask that you please assist us in this regard and help ensure that the event can be conducted safely and with minimal disruption to road users.

Spare wheel vehicles will be provided for each grade. Spares are to be labeled with your name, race number, race category and 10 or 11 speed. All wheels put in as spares will be classified as neutral spares and if you need to access a spare wheel(s), you will be given a wheel(s) from the first spares vehicle in your age category. You may end up with someone else's wheel(s) to finish the stage. Please make sure that you give the wheel(s) back to the spare wheel vehicle after the stage end. **Riders who do not provide spare wheels will not be able to access any spare wheels.**

Support will be given to lead riders and some riders may at times have no spares support. All riders are encouraged to carry a pump and spare tube as there may be long periods before a rider will encounter a spares vehicle if they become separated from their main race bunch.

The event is time based with total elapsed time counting towards the General Classification
 Time bonuses awarded to stage placings are:

In the time trial no time bonuses are given. Actual time differences will be added to the General Classification time.

In the case of a dead heat occurring in the general classification, the time for the time trial using the actual times recorded by the timing system/timekeepers, will be used to decide the result.

KOM/QOM competition is conducted for Under 17 Men & Under 17 Women only.
 Place getters are awarded points towards the KOM competition. Point allocations are:

There are no time bonuses awarded for the KOM sprints.

Riders must complete the road race stage to be eligible for KOM/QOM points. Dispensation for mechanical mishaps or accidents will be at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire. Riders must attempt to complete each stage to be eligible to start the next stage and be eligible for General Classification ranking. Dispensation for mechanical mishaps or accidents will be at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire. The Chief Commissaire reserves the right to withdraw riders lagging well behind the main field or if they suffer a mechanical failure. If this occurs, the rider(s) will be given the time of the last rider finishing plus 60 seconds and the rider(s) will be able to start the next stage. Riders who suffer a Medical Issue and have to withdraw from a stage may be able to start the next stage at the discretion of the Chief Commissaire in consultation with the Race Director.

Bike Information

Race Commissaries will check **all** bike roll-outs both days prior to the start of Stage 1 and Stage 4. All bikes will be rolled out and checked prior to the start of Stage 3 the Individual Time Trial. It is the rider's responsibility to ensure they have the correct roll-out before each stage. Riders are to present to the roll out area in a timely manner on Saturday prior to Stage 1 & Sunday prior to Stage 3 & Stage 4. Immediately after each stage Race Commissaires will check the first 5 placings for all categories and other riders as directed by the Chief Commissaire. Riders are to present to the roll out area as soon as they have finished the stage.

There are to be no time trial bikes or carbon wheels used during the event.

Tour Leader and KOM jerseys –

- Wirtgen Group Centrals Tour Leader jerseys & U17 KOM/QOM leader jerseys will be given out prior to the start of each stage. (Stage 2 from the sign on desk; Stage 3 at the Presentation Dinner, Stage 4 from the sign on desk)
- These are to be worn by the leaders of GC & KOM/QOM for all road race stages.
- If the leader of KOM/QOM is also the leader of the GC, then the next placed rider in KOM/QOM is to wear the KOM/QOM jersey for the stage.
- All jerseys must be returned at the conclusion of each stage, unless the leader position is maintained.
- Overall General Classification and KOM winners will be presented with jerseys to keep at the conclusion of the event.

Riders will need to bring their Race License with them to the rider sign on desk, which will be held until the end of the event.

Sunday 7.30am – 8.45am

U13 Riders will need to bring their Race License with them to the rider sign on desk.

U17's & U15's will be required to sign on for the day.

STAGE 1 Road Race [Mass Start]

Please Note: Riders failing to sign on prior to 9.45 a.m. may be deemed to have scratched.

** All categories will start the stage under Race Neutral, until turning onto Crennis Mines Rd.
The race will then start under the direction of the Commissaire.

Under 17 Men 48.3kms (plus 2kms race neutral) **start time: 10:00am**

Start South Australian Company Store (Valley Rd). Continue on Valley Rd and turn right onto Radford Rd and then turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd. **Race start is here under direction from Commissaire.** Continue along Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Long Gully Rd, which becomes Menglers Hill Rd, **KOM** at top of climb. Turn left onto Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd, turn left onto Eden Valley Rd and turn left onto Valley Rd to cross finish line & complete lap 1.

Follow same directions to complete second lap to FINISH LINE at SA Company Store. **KOM** in same place: at top of climb on 2nd lap.

Under 17 Women 48.3kms (plus 2kms race neutral) **start time: 10:05am**

Start South Australian Company Store (Valley Rd). Continue on Valley Rd and turn right onto Radford Rd and then turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd. **Race start is here under direction from Commissaire.** Continue along Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Long Gully Rd, which becomes Menglers Hill Rd, **QOM** at top of climb. Turn left onto Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd, turn left onto Eden Valley Rd and turn left onto Valley Rd to cross finish line & complete lap 1.

Follow same directions to complete second lap to FINISH LINE at SA Company Store. **QOM** in same place: at top of climb on 2nd lap.

Under 15 Men 23.1kms (plus 2kms race neutral) **start time 10:10am**

Under 15 Women 23.1kms (plus 2kms race neutral) **start time 10:10am**

Start South Australian Company Store (Valley Rd). Continue on Valley Rd and turn right onto Radford Rd and then turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd. **Race start is here under direction from Commissaire.** Continue along Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Long Gully Rd, which becomes Menglers Hill Rd, turn left onto Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd, turn left onto Eden Valley Rd and turn left onto Valley Rd to cross FINISH LINE.

STAGE 2 Road Race [Mass Start]

CDCC Tour leader jerseys & U17 KOM/QOM jerseys will be given out prior to the stage start and are to be worn by the leaders of GC & KOM/QOM. If the leader of KOM/QOM is also the leader of the GC, then the next placed rider is to wear the KOM/QOM jersey.

**** All categories will start the stage under Race Neutral until turning onto Crennis Mines Rd. The race will then start under the direction of the Commissaire.**

Category start times may be slightly later as it will depend on when all riders have finished Stage 1

Under 17 Men 51.8kms (plus 2kms race neutral) **start time: 1:30pm**

Start South Australian Company Store (Valley Rd). Continue on Valley Rd and turn right onto Radford Rd and turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd. **Race start is here under direction from Commissaire.** Continue along Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Stockwell Rd, veer right onto Vines Vale Rd, turn left onto Light Pass Rd, turn Left onto Menglers Hill Rd, **KOM** at top of climb. Turn right onto Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd, turn left onto Valley Rd, turn left onto Valley Rd to cross finish line & complete 1st lap. Continue on Valley Rd, turn right onto Radford Rd, turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Long Gully Rd. Continue along Long Gully Rd which becomes Menglers Hill Rd. **KOM** at top of climb. Continue on Valley Rd and turn right onto Radford Rd and turn left onto Crennis Mines Rd. **Race start is here under direction from Commissaire.** Continue along Crennis Mines Rd, turn left onto Stockwell Rd, veer right onto Vines Vale Rd, turn left onto Light Pass Rd, turn Left onto Menglers Hill Rd, **QOM** at top of climb. Turn right onto Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd, turn left onto Eden Valley Rd and turn left onto Valley Rd to cross FINISH LINE.

The race will be 'controlled' along Tanunda Creek Rd until they turn left onto Flaxmans Valley Rd. Riders are to stay in a group for the 'controlled' section. This is to allow the riders to practice racing and gain confidence in a group. Adult riders will ride with the group to encourage correct racing etiquette is followed.

Start at intersection of Menglers Hill Rd and Tanunda Creek Rd. Head along Tanunda Creek Rd, turn left at Flaxman Valley Rd, turn left onto Eden Valley Rd and turn left onto Valley Rd to cross FINISH LINE.
